Five Module Scores BIBLICAL WORLDVIEW

MODULE 1

Bible, Truths and Morals

You are a World Citizen

This series of questions examined what you believe about the Bible and how it affects your behavior; your perspectives on the concept and pursuit of truth; and your ideas about discerning right and wrong (i.e., morality), and what that looks like in practice.

National Norms:

12% – Integrated Disciples

13% – Emergent Followers

76% – World Citizens

MODULE 2

Faith Practices

You are a World Citizen

This series of questions examined your application of what you believe about the Bible and how you put those perspectives into practice. This includes: beliefs and activity related to evangelism, worship, prayer, confession, and spiritual growth; and how you handle purpose, temptation and, sin.

National Norms:

20% – Integrated Disciples
18% – Emergent Followers
62% – World Citizens

MODULE 3

God, Creation and History

You are a World Citizen

This series of questions examined what you believe about the existence, nature, and work of the God of Israel, the Trinity, Satan, and the meaning of world history.

National Norms:

12% – Integrated Disciples
13% – Emergent Followers
76% – World Citizens

MODULE 4

Lifestyle, Behavior and Relationships

You are a World Citizen

This series of questions explored your perspectives related to your lifestyle activities and preferences, how you interact with resources and opportunities, and the nature and goal of your interpersonal relationships.

National Norms:

13% – Integrated Disciples
11% – Emergent Followers
76% – World Citizens

MODULE 5

Sin, Salvation and God Relationship

You are a World Citizen

This series included questions regarding how you think about and address sin; your beliefs and choices related to personal salvation; and the nature and pursuit of your relationship with God.

National Norms:

11% – Integrated Disciples
14% – Emergent Followers
76% – World Citizens

How to Read These Results:

Your answers to the Arizona Christian University Worldview Assessment place you in one of three segments in relation to having a biblical worldview.

INTEGRATED DISCIPLE

If you have a biblical worldview, then you are identified as an Integrated Disciple. That name indicates someone whose beliefs and behaviors reflect the consistent integration of biblical truths and principles into how they view and respond to the world. That integration significantly shapes their life and enables them to think like Jesus so that they may live like Jesus Christ – i.e., they are His disciples.

EMERGENT FOLLOWER

If you do not have a biblical worldview, but currently possess enough beliefs and behaviors to reasonably contend that you could develop such a way of life, then you are categorized as an Emergent Follower. Such people typically are in the process of becoming disciples of Jesus, so the Assessment scores may provide valuable insights and the impetus toward becoming more like Jesus – and a modern-day disciple of His.

WORLD CITIZEN

If your Assessment responses indicate that you are currently not close to possessing the accumulation of beliefs and behaviors that reflect a biblical worldview, then you are classified as a World Citizen. These are often individuals who think of themselves as Christian, but whose core beliefs and related behaviors inconsistently reflect foundational biblical principles. Such a score will hopefully motivate World Citizens to re-examine their beliefs and behaviors to move farther down the path of Christ-likeness.

Summary:

None of these scores or descriptions are meant as a judgment, either positive or negative; they are simply a reflection of where you stand today in relation to core biblical principles and applications. How you accept and respond to your worldview assessment is up to you. Beyond the determination of your primary worldview, the module scores shared below provide additional detail concerning the areas of strength and weakness related to how Bible-driven your worldview is.

You will notice that the same designations – Integrated Disciple, Emergent Follower, and World Citizen – are used to describe how your answers lined up with biblical principles in each of the five areas of questions shown. It is possible to consistently think and live biblically in one or more of those areas but not in others. By examining your classification in each of the modules you will be better able to identify aspects of your worldview that need greater attention if you are determined to become more like Jesus in your beliefs and behavior.

Also note that for the sake of context, we have inserted the national norms pertaining to each module.
